




Review the eligibility check list to ensure that your project is eligible.

All eligibility requirements must be checked off to submit a report. If your project is eligible, please skip to page 4 of this handout to continue with the "Report Details" page.


If not all are selected, the "Notice" page will appear next.




If "Yes" is selected, you will return to the previous page to review the eligibility criteria.




If "Region project" is selected, you will be asked to select your Soroptimist Region from the dropdown menu.




