Initiating Club

Links Within SIA

If you are having trouble contacting the club you wish to link with, please email SIA headquarters at siahq@soroptimist.org.

If the club accepts your link request, you may download a <u>writeable friendship certificate</u> from the program section of the Member's Area of the SIA web site. Download one for your link, too.

Please let the program department (program@soroptimist.org) at SIA headquarters know about your new link so that it can be included in the Friendship Link directory.

Links Outside of SIA

If you know a specific club in another federation with which you would like to link, forward this application to the appropriate federation Friendship Link coordinator listed on the application.

If the club accepts your link request, you may download a <u>writeable friendship certificate</u> from the program section of the Member's Area of the SIA web site. Download one for your link, too.
