The Grantee is responsible for travel expenses to and from Los Angeles, visa and immigration documentation as required, proof of medical insurance while on the grant, and items of personal nature. Lodging, meals, hospitality, professional educational visits and travel between the host clubs will be provided by the region. The Soroptimist Grantee is expected to speak to host clubs at the Region Conference in April, communicating information about the Grantee's home club and region, and the service projects undertaken by both.

Please email or mail a one-page application letter by December 15, 2018. The letter should include the applicant's personal and professional information, why they wish to receive the grant, and information about the applicant's involvement in Soroptimist.
