Convention Location

The 45th Biennial Convention will be held at the <u>Pacifico Yokohama</u>. Its beautiful exterior, designed to bring to mind ocean waves, wind, and sunlight, has become the new symbol of the historic and cosmopolitan city of Yokohama. All its world-class facilities expand the possibilities for conventions. The convenient location and superb surroundings of water and greenery will create an outstanding environment for our convention.

Registration Fees

The non-delegate registration fee for convention will be JPY 60,000 for the full convention or JPY 32,000 per day for daily registration. Fees increase after May 30, 2018.

Airports Information into Japan and Airline Carrier Discounts

There are two major airports serving the greater Tokyo area of Japan—Narita (NRT) and Haneda (HND). Haneda is the closer airport and is only 14 miles from Yokohama. Narita is 57 miles from Yokohama.

Reservations for the hearing and speech impaired are also available at 1-800-543-1586. Zone fares are not valid for markets where American does not publish a fare. Certain restrictions apply.

Hotel Accommodations

We will have hotel rooms at various costs available near the Pacifico Yokohama. Our convention hotel is the <u>Intercontinental Yokohama</u>. Soroptimist discounted hotel reservations—for all our Yokohama hotels—will be handled through one website and offered in both English and Japanese. Rooms at the Intercontinental will range from JPY 21,060 – JPY 35,000 inclusive of tax and fees. Lower cost options will be available. Preview the hotel list.

Hotel reservations will be available in January and will be part of the convention registration information. We ask all of our participants to book their hotel reservations through the link provided on the SIA website. SIA has secured specially-priced hotel rooms around the convention center. Please note that booking hotel rooms without using our designated link may result in SIA paying a penalty if we do not meet our contractual obligations.

Interpretation

Interpretation will be provided in Japanese, Mandarin Chinese, Korean, Spanish and Portuguese for all general sessions, and workshops held in the Pacifico National Hall and Hall C/D. There will not be interpretation at the Writing Our Wishes Reception.

Meals and Special Events

There will be a number of special events for which you can register as part of the convention at an additional cost. These include:

• Writing our Wishes Reception. This welcome reception will take place on Monday, July 30 from 6:00 – 7:30 pm. There will be limited tickets for this event. The cost is JPY 8,000.

- Cultural events. Our members from Japan will delight us in offering hands on special events that will include tea ceremony, calligraphy, and kimono. These will take place on Monday, July 30th in the afternoon. The cost is JPY 2,500.
- Laurel Society Event. Celebrating the music and fashion of Yokohama in the 1960s and 1970s, this event will take place Tuesday, July 31st from 6:00 to 7:30 pm for active Laurel Society members (have given \$360 in the 2016-2018 biennium) and new Laurel Society members (minimal donation: \$1,000). - Our Shining Stars: Recognition Banquet. We will recognize our incoming and outgoing leaders and enjoy a lovely dinner and entertainment. This will take place on Wednesday, August 1 starting with a reception at 6:30 and dinner at 7:00. The cost will by JPY 18,500.
- Bento Box lunches. Bento box lunches will be available for advance purchase for lunch on Tuesday July 31
 and Wednesday August 1. Bento boxes will be distributed outside of workshop rooms. The cost for Bento
 Boxes will be JPY 3,000.

Convention Fee

The convention fee is \$495 USD per club. Invoices will be mailed in January 2018 and are due **March 15, 2018**. This fee covers the convention registration for the club delegate whether they attend or not. Meal tickets are not included.

Suggested Dress

The average temperature in Yokohama in July/August is a low of 72° F (22° C) and a high of 86° F (30° C). Business or business casual attire is recommended for the meetings and luncheons. Dressy attire is recommended for the Recognition Banquet. Bring a sweater or light jacket to wear during the meetings as the convention center is airconditioned.

Yokohama

Yokohama is a beautiful modern city located on the Pacific Ocean. It is the first harbor city introduced to the world as the entrance to Japan. Since the time the port was opened, Yokohama has been vigorously acquiring new cultures and information from foreign countries, and introducing to Japan new food and a wide range of cultures. Thus, Yokohama is considered the birthplace of Japan's modern culture. The total population of Yokohama is 3.7 million people, making the city the second largest after Tokyo's 23 Wards. Yokohama is considered a city of dreams for the citizens of Japan, who are very proud of living there. Visa Requests

In addition to passports, Japan requires visas from a number of SIA countries, including Bolivia, Brazil, Colombia, Ecuador, Palau, Panama, Peru, and Venezuela. In order to get a visa, you must be registered for convention. After receiving your registration, please forward your confirmation to sia2018-reg@convention.co.jp to request your visa letter.

Since a Visa to Japan is valid only for 3 months, Visa Documents will be prepared from the end of April and will be delivered around May. Your understanding and patience would be much appreciated.
