2025 Budget Reconciliation Law (H.R.1) Impacts for Southeast Asian Americans

HEALTH AND SAFETY NETS

Many Southeast Asian Americans (SEAAs) rely on federal programs

- Nearly 20% of SEAAs live at or below the income threshold for Medicaid eligibility.
- The Affordable Care Act (ACA) has greatly expanded health coverage for SEAAs through its coverage, as restrictions to ACA's tax credit pool across health insurance premiums and make health care less affordable for SEAAs.
- SNAP recipients: Hmong (18%), Cambodian (18%), Laotian (18%), Vietnamese (14%).
